“The 2005 Edge is a blend of 85 percent cabernet sauvignon with 15 percent merlot, all sourced from Napa Valley. Characteristics of cedar, green pepper, smoke and tobacco, balanced by a soft plumminess. Overall, the wines show good extraction, good berry structure, along with no bitterness and the tannins are surprisingly supple. Solid Cabernet at a reasonable price.”
