TASTING NOTES:

2017 Edge is dense and luscious. A deep ruby red color, the wine is drinking beautifully right out of bottle. Intense cassis fruit interlaced with strawberry jam, blueberries and a burst of floral and vanilla notes. Soft and supple on tannins, the finish is long with notes of herbal tea and chamomile.

HARVEST NOTES:

2017 began with abundant rainfall. Spring weather was mild, resulting in extended flowering in some areas, with little shatter. Vines were vigorous through the summer thanks to the winter rains. Three heat events, including one over Labor Day weekend, kicked harvest into high gear, but cool weather immediately after allowed sugar levels to return to normal.
