Ray Signorello was looking for cutting-edge wine at a good price when he launched Edge, and it's been sourced from Alexander Valley grapes since 2014. It's friendly in texture, full in red and black fruit like cherries and blackberries, full-bodied but moderate in tannins. Drink now or hold.

91 - VINOUS, Dec. 2023

The 2021 Cabernet Sauvignon is a bold, racy wine. A burst of super-ripe red cherry fruit, plum, mocha, licorice and sweet oak is amplified in this extroverted Cabernet Sauvignon from Edge proprietor Ray Signorello. There's a good deal of Alexander Valley earthy/savory complexity to play off of the wine's natural exuberance. It's a gorgeous wine for the money.

HARVEST NOTES:

2021 came as a welcome relief on the heels of a stressful 2020 vintage. It was recorded as one of the driest years with limited rainfalls supply. Cool nights and full sun days with no danger of major heat spikes, resulted in a small crop but with near perfect flavor development and concentration. The resulting wines are well structured, showing power and fine quality tannin expressions. Their complexity will continue to unveil over the next few decades.
